

Hong Kong - Barcelona Urban Exchange : A Dual Approach to Waterfront Regeneration

About the Symposium

The Hong Kong SAR Government together with the Hong Kong Institute of Urban Design, the Hong Kong Institute of Planners, and the Hong Kong Green Building Council and the Government of Barcelona City have collaborated to form an urban exchange platform. A symposium titled “Hong Kong – Barcelona Urban Exchange: A Dual Approach to Waterfront Regeneration” will be held in Feb 2014 in Hong Kong as the first event of the urban exchange platform. It aims to share and explore the urban development experiences on issues among the two cities – Hong Kong and Barcelona. 
