

Faculty of Engineering Academic Scholarship for Outstanding HKDSE Admittees:

To recognize the outstanding academic performance of HKDSE students, the Faculty of Engineering will grant academic scholarship for HKDSE students admitted to full-time undergraduate degree programmes offered by the Faculty of Engineering and its constituent departments/division in 2016 – 17.

Details are listed below:

Introduction	The Faculty of Engineering accords recognition to outstanding HKDSE students admitted to its full-time undergraduate degree programmes and grants them scholarship of various amounts on the basis of academic merit. All outstanding HKDSE admittees to the full-time undergraduate degree programmes offered by the Faculty of Engineering and its constituent departments and division (Department of Computing, Department of Electrical Engineering, Department of Electronic and Information Engineering, Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering, Department of Mechanical Engineering and Interdisciplinary Division of Biomedical Engineering) will be considered for the Scholarship.						
Eligibility	<p>The Faculty of Engineering academic scholarship is guaranteed if you are a current year Secondary Six student who meets the University's general entrance requirements for admission to the Faculty's full-time undergraduate degree programmes offered by the Faculty of Engineering and its constituent departments/division <u>AND</u> fulfils all the requirements listed in points (1) to (3) under the section "Requirements of the Scholarship" below.</p> <p>There is no need for students to apply separately for the Scholarship. The Faculty will identify outstanding HKDSE admittees and will inform you if you are awarded the scholarship (one-off or renewable) at the end of your first year of study. The one-off scholarship and the first instalment of a renewable scholarship will be distributed at the first semester of the second year of study.</p> <p>If you receive a renewable scholarship, you will be notified whether you are eligible for renewal of scholarship at the end of the second and third year of study, whenever applicable. The Scholarship will be distributed at the first semester of third and fourth years of study, whenever applicable. That is to say, you will be awarded a renewable Scholarship for a maximum of 3 years in total (in Year 2 to Year 4), subject to meeting the conditions for renewal as stated in (3) (ii) of "Requirements of the Scholarship".</p>

<p>[^] Level 5** in any one of the Extended Mathematics modules will also be taken into account for scholarship consideration.</p> <p>⁻ For the purpose of calculating the admission scores, HKDSE level attainments will be converted to level points where Level 5**=7, 5*=6, 5=5, 4=4, 3=3, 2=2, 1=1 and Unclassified=0.</p> <p>Academic Requirements:</p> <p>(3) (i) Academic requirement at your first year of study in PolyU (applicable for one off and renewable scholarship)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the end of your first year of study (excluding the summer term). <p>(ii) Additional academic requirement at your second and third year of study in PolyU (applicable for renewable scholarship only)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligibility for renewal of scholarship will be reviewed on a yearly basis at the end of Semester Two, and continuation of scholarship is conditional upon your attaining a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 at the end of your second year and third year of study at PolyU, excluding the summer term. If you fail to get the required cumulative GPA of 3.5 (excluding the summer term), you will not be eligible for the scholarship anymore for the rest of your study. 		
Remarks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under the University's "Guideline Governing the Concurrent Holding of Scholarships", a student can concurrently hold more than one scholarship administered by the University in an academic year if the total value of scholarships received by him/her does not exceed his/her annual tuition fee payable plus HK\$40,000 unless otherwise specified. • Your eligibility for the scholarship will lapse automatically if you terminate your study at PolyU Faculty of Engineering or change your mode of study from full-time to part-time or you fail to comply with university policies/regulations and the laws of Hong Kong. • Scholarship will not be granted for the year in which you defer your study. • PolyU reserves the absolute right to change the terms or withdraw the above scholarship at its sole determination. In case of any dispute/disagreement, PolyU's decision is final and binding.
