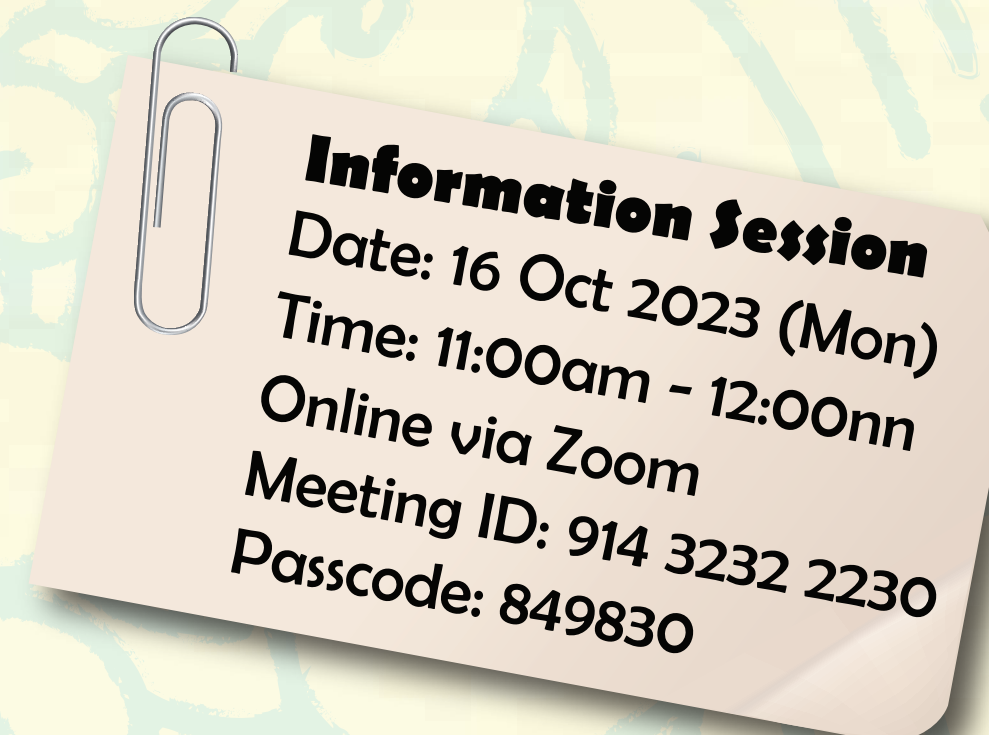

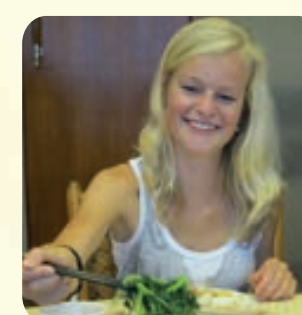
**Minor in Chinese Language and Culture (for International Students)** is tailored for both international and non-Chinese speaking local students. It is an excellent opportunity for you to learn **Chinese Language and Culture** while pursuing your degree at PolyU!

**Students who have successfully completed the programme will be able to:**

- possess rudimentary Chinese language competences;
- have the basic communication skills to function in familiar contexts in a Chinese community; and
- have a general understanding of major aspects of Chinese culture.

**Credit requirement:** 18 credits (of which 9 credits at level 3 or above)

- 2 compulsory subjects; and 4 elective subjects
- Students may count up to 6 credits from their Major, i.e. DSR, or GUR subjects towards the Minor.



### Entrance Requirement & Pre-requisite

- International students, including non-Chinese speaking (NCS) local students, enrolled in full-time UGC-funded undergraduate programmes with GPA of 2.5 or above
- Students who should have completed any one of the following Chinese language subjects:
  - CLC1151 Chinese I (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC1152 Chinese II (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC2151 Chinese III (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC2152 Chinese Literature – Linguistic and Cultural Perspectives (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC2154 Chinese IV (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC3152 Spoken Chinese for Business Communication (for non-Chinese speaking students) or
  - CLC3153 Chinese Reading and Writing (for non-Chinese speaking Students) or
  - the equivalent
