A decrease in the permeability of aquaporin zero as a possible cause for presbyopia

<u>Abstract</u>

This presentation includes a novel hypothesis related to presbyopia in which the permeability of the lens fibers to aquaporin is central. Without fluid movement across the lens, it loses power of accommodation.
