

The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) is honoured to receive the **Excellence in "3G+" Diversity Award (Internal 3G+ Impact)** from the International Astronautical Federation (IAF), making it the first tertiary institution in China and East Asia to receive this esteemed accolade. The Award recognises PolyU's leadership and its contributions to fostering a more diverse and inclusive academic and research environment in the global aerospace sector.

Established by the IAF Inclusion, Diversity, and Equity Administrative Committee (IDEA), the prestigious IAF Excellence in "3G+" Diversity Award comprises two categories: Internal and External 3G+ Impact. It recognises IAF member organisations worldwide for their efforts in promoting "3G" (Geography, Generation, Gender) diversity both internally and externally within the aerospace sector. The Award was officially presented at the International Astronautical Congress (IAC) 2025, held in Sydney, Australia this September.
