# **Broad-based Curriculum for All-round Academic Development**

Studying at PolyU is more than earning a degree—it's a rich experience with many opportunities for learning and growth. Our four-year undergraduate degree programme is designed to provide flexible, student-centred, and holistic professional education that aligns with PolyU's goals and mission. Under this structure, students are required to complete a minimum of 120 credits for graduation:



The flexible Common Year 1 Curriculum\* helps students adjust to university life, **explore a variety of subjects**, and **build a strong foundation in their faculty** before selecting a programme that best matches their interests and strengths.

Starting from the 2025/26 academic year, PolyU offers different pathways for students to enable them to tailor their studies to better suit their personal interests. Students with clear academic goals can choose their preferred programmes directly, while those who wish to further explore their aspirations can enrol in one of the **six new bachelor's degree schemes** to gain a better understanding about the different majors within a faculty. Students can also consider our new Bachelor's Degree Scheme in Interdisciplinary Studies, which allows them to design their Major by following a structured curriculum framework for interdisciplinary studies.

PolyU offers an experience-focused curriculum through its Work-Integrated Education (WIE) programme and Service-Learning (SL) initiative.

As the first tertiary institution in Hong Kong to incorporate a mandatory WIE component into the undergraduate curriculum, PolyU requires students to complete internships relevant to their academic major, either locally or abroad. This component provides valuable work-based learning experiences that foster all-round development and enhance professional competencies. Meanwhile, the SL initiative integrates meaningful service components into academic studies, nurturing students to become both competent and caring professionals.
