Research Topic:	Evaluation of a Positive Youth Development Program for Chinese Adolescents
Short Description of the Research Project:	Positive youth development programs can help to promote holistic development of young people. In the past decade, we have developed the Tin Ka Ping P.A.T.H.S. Project and implemented it in some schools in mainland China. During the pandemic, we collected evaluation data from students after they had completed the project using a standardised questionnaire (N = 3,000+).  In this project, we will evaluate the project by examining the responses of the students to the items in the questionnaire. We will also examine psychosocial correlates of student satisfaction of the program.  The secondary school students joining this project will learn: 1) questionnaire design; 2) evaluation using survey; 3) descriptive statistical analyses; 4) inferential statistical analyses; and 5) statistical software used in social science research.
