Research Topic:	A Stand-alone Therapeutic Music-with-Movement Programme for People with Cognitive Impairment
Short Description of the Research Project:	People with cognitive impairment experience anxiety depression, and/ or other psychological and behavioural symptoms, which significantly impact their quality of life. Music-with-Movement has been demonstrated in previous research studies that showed significant improvements in cognitive functions and emotional well-being in older adults with dementia in Hong Kong. The current project has taken a new approach by integrating augmented reality, motion- sensing, and cloud computing technology in the implementation of the music-with-movement intervention. The current project provides a distinctive opportunity for the
	participating students to explore health-related research. They will be able to: 1) learn about the conditions and health-care needs of people with cognitive impairment;
	2) understand how gerontechnology can benefit the quality of life of the older adults; and
	3) get an early exposure in healthcare industry.
	The selected and trained students will be able to join our hands to make health assessments with older adults with

	cognitive impairment and to support our observation in the program implementation in local community centres and/ or residential care units.
