Research Topic:	Financial Literacy and Gambling Behaviour: Evidence from Hong Kong
Short Description of the Research Project:	<p>The objectives of the project are to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) examine the role of financial literacy in contributing to the gambling behaviours of help-seeking problem gamblers (aged between 18 to 50); 2) investigate associations between financial literacy, perceived financial socialization from family members or romantic partner, individual's socio-economic background, and gambling behaviours; and 3) understand problem gamblers' perception of financial literacy and gambling behaviours in everyday lives. <p>Students will be invited to join the project to understand the problem gamblers' perception of financial literacy and gambling behaviours through participating in the qualitative research by conducting individual in-depth interviews or surveys with help-seeking problem gamblers and their family members or romantic partners.</p>
