| Short Description of the Research Project: | The objectives of the project are to: 1) examine the role of financial literacy in contributing to the gambling behaviours of help-seeking problem gamblers (aged between 18 to 50); 2) investigate associations between financial literacy, perceived financial socialization from family members or romantic partner, individual's socio-economic background, and gambling behaviours; and 3) understand problem gamblers' perception of financial literacy and gambling behaviours in everyday lives. Students will be invited to join the project to understand the problem gamblers' perception of financial literacy and gambling behaviours through participating in the qualitative research by conducting individual in-depth interviews or surveys with help-seeking problem gamblers and their family members or romantic partners. |
