

# VENUE

- Make good use of recycling bins in the venue

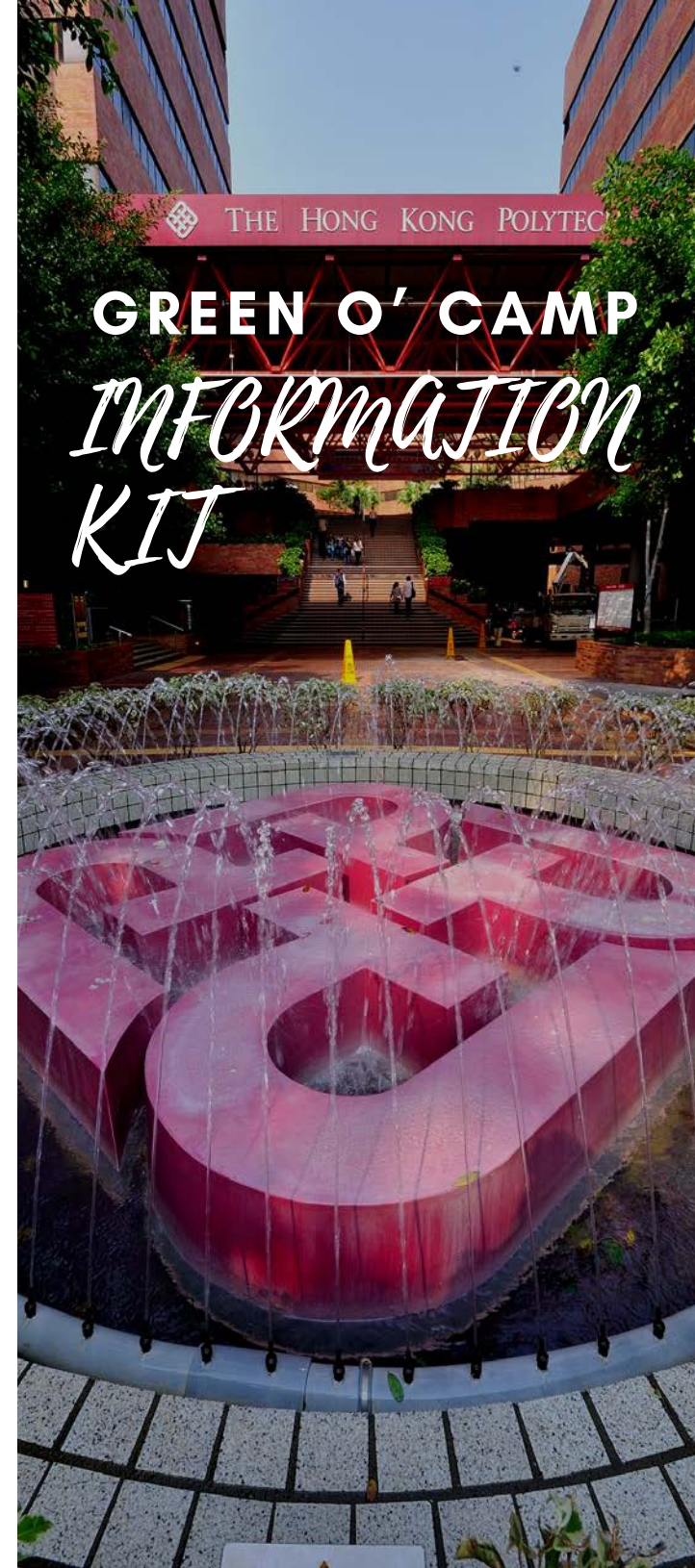
