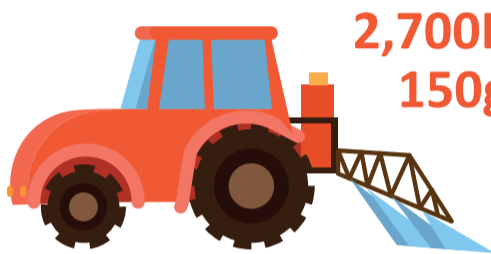

## What's Fast Fashion?

It describes the quick production of clothing collections that captures current luxury fashion trend at low cost, thus allowing consumers to buy clothing items inexpensively.

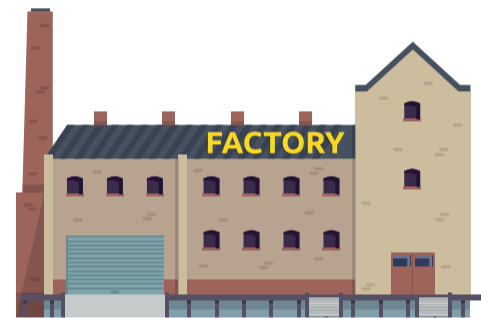
Let's look at some facts about this industry:



**2,700L of water and 150g of pesticides** are used to produce cotton for one t-shirt



Over **90 million items of clothing** end up in landfills around the world each year



The 8-storey Rana Plaza building in Bangladesh, house to five garment factories, collapsed in 2013. This accident killed over 1,130 and injured over 2,500 workers. It revealed the unethical and poor labor conditions as factories often rush for quick production at the expense of safe working conditions.

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The clothing industry is the **second-most** polluter of clean water

Fast fashion results in large volumes of production and come with tight deadlines. **Overcrowding** and **unsafe working conditions** are common for workers in the fast fashion industry. Workers often work **overtime**.
