Hong Kong is home to a high diversity of dragonflies. Since the first local record made in 1854, Hong Kong has recorded a total of 128 dragonfly species, and some species are very special or endemic to Hong Kong.

# The Dragonfly Species Endemic to Hong Kong:

### Hong Kong Clubtail 香港纖春蜓

Leptogomphus hongkongensis

## The Smallest Dragonfly in the World:

### Scarlet Dwarf 侏紅小蜻

Nannophya pyqmaea



#### Features

 Hong Kong Clubtail is a medium-sized black and yellow dragonfly with bright green eyes



#### **Features**

- Less than 2cm long, the Scarlet Dwarf is the smallest dragonfly in the world
- The upper anal appendages (上肛附器) of the males are white and horn-shaped – this color and shape are unique among the dragonflies

- The males are brilliant red with bright red eyes
- The females are mainly yellowish brown
