

## Easy DIY Lai-see Lantern

Materials required:  
• 8 lai-see packets



Reference: Upcycling Living



1 Cut 8 circles out of lai-see packets.



2 Fold the three edges towards the middle to make a triangle.



3 Glue the 4 pieces together to make the top and bottom segments.



4 Use the rest packet papers to make a loop. Thread it through the top segment and tape it onto the inside.



5 Glue the top and bottom segments to form a lai-see lantern.
