Duties

The appointee will assist the project leader in the research project "Well-Being Design Guide in Public Housing Development". He/she will be required to:

- (a) conduct systematic literature review;
- (b) conduct personal in-depth interviews and focus group interviews;
- (c) analyses quantitative and qualitative data, including large-scale surveys, interview data, and GPS location-tracking travel patterns;
- (d) write up final consultancy reports for government departments;
- (e) coordinate the overall project logistics and liaise with stakeholders including corporations, governmental bodies, non-governmental organizations, media, and specific underprivileged groups; and
- (f) handle any other duties as assigned by the project leader.

Qualifications

Applicants should:

- (a) have a doctoral degree, preferably in architecture, urban design, or housing research related disciplines;
- (b) have no more than three years of post-qualification experience at the time of application;
- (c) have knowledge of and experience in handling quantitative and qualitative data;
- (d) be independent, self-motivated and responsible to lead various research tasks.
- (e) have an excellent command of both spoken English and Cantonese.

Preference will be given to those with a PhD degree in a related field.
