Duties

The appointee will be required to:

- (a) provide physiotherapy services to patients attending the Rehabilitation Clinic;
- (b) provide on-field physiotherapy service;
- (c) conduct health-related talks and exercise classes;
- (d) supervise on-site and off-site clinical placements;
- (e) provide administrative support;
- (f) assist in the promotion and development of clinic services;
- (g) participate in classroom teaching and practical/laboratory sessions; and
- (h) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of Department or his/her delegates.

Qualifications

Applicants should:

- (a) have a bachelor's degree in Physiotherapy or equivalent, preferably with a master's degree in Sports Physiotherapy / Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy / Neurological Rehabilitation;
- (b) be registered with the Hong Kong Physiotherapists Board and have a valid practising certificate;
- (c) have at least five years of relevant post-qualification working experience in the fields such as sports physiotherapy / musculoskeletal physiotherapy / neurological rehabilitation;
- (d) have proven clinical experience and skills in the areas of musculoskeletal / neurological rehabilitation;
- (e) have good interpersonal and communication skills; and
- (f) be independent and able to work with other disciplines.
