#### Duties

The appointee will be required to:

- (c) provide quality teaching at undergraduate or postgraduate level;
- (d) contribute to the Centre's service; and
- (e) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of Institute, the Centre Director or their delegates.

# Qualifications

Applicants should:

- (a) have a doctoral degree and preferably postdoctoral experience in:
  - thermal comfort modelling; or
  - heat and mass transfer in fibrous systems; or
  - functional clothing and textiles; or
  - a related discipline;
- (b) have demonstrated promise of a high level of creativity in research in some subdivisions of his/her field;
- (c) be able to demonstrate effective interdisciplinary teamwork; and
- (d) be highly proficient in written and spoken English. Other language skill like Putonghua is an additional advantage.
