Teaching Fellow in Fashion Design (Ref. 19050302)

Duties

The appointee will be required to:

- (a) engage in teaching and learning activities, and conduct lectures, tutorials, seminars and practical sessions on the related subject areas;
- (b) prepare and develop materials, design teaching and assessment strategies, deliver teaching in academic settings appropriate for the objective of learning, interact with and motivate students, and assess the performance of and give feedback to students;
- (c) contribute to the development of subject curriculum and pedagogy, overall teaching and learning approaches/strategies as well as subject administration;
- (d) assist in the development and management of relevant teaching facilities;
- (e) participate in pedagogical research and consultancy projects; and
- (f) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of Institute or his delegates.

Qualifications

Applicants should have:

- (a) a master's degree, preferably with a PhD, in a relevant discipline or a relevant professional qualification plus not less than three years of post-qualification tertiary teaching experience and/or industrial experience in knitwear design and technology, preferably with international experience;
- (b) a sound knowledge of fashion design, fashion theory, fashion styling, pattern cutting, garment construction for menswear and womenswear, and technical skills of computer design software;
- (c) an established track record of fashion research outputs in traditional publication OR non-traditional formats such as design residencies, exhibitions, fashion shows, with postgraduate supervisions being an advantage; and
- (d) good communication skills and be able to use English as the medium of instruction.

Applicants are expected to submit their fashion design portfolios including ten samples of their creative works in PDF format, with a brief description for each piece, together with the completed application.

Remuneration and Conditions of Service

A highly competitive remuneration package will be offered. Initial appointment will be on a fixed-term gratuity-bearing contract. Re-engagement thereafter is subject to mutual agreement. Applicants should state their current and expected salary in the application.
