Duties

The appointees will be required to:

- (a) conduct research and secure external research funding;
- (b) undertake teaching duties at undergraduate and postgraduate levels;
- (c) supervise research students; and
- (d) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of School and/or his delegates.

Qualifications

Applicants should:

- (a) have a PhD degree in Optometry or Vision Science;
- (b) have the relevant postdoctoral research experience in Optometry and Vision Science (as supported by evidence of research projects and outputs) and relevant teaching experience; and
- (c) demonstrate potential for establishing significant externally funded research programmes.

Remuneration and Conditions of Service
