**Occupational Therapist I (Tam Wing Fan Rehabilitation Service Centre) (Ref. 21040703-IE)**

**Duties**

The appointee will be required to:

- (a) develop occupational therapy services at the Rehabilitation Service Centre;
- (b) provide occupational therapy services to clients, including but not limited to, musculoskeletal rehabilitation, medical and neurological rehabilitation, work rehabilitation and child development training;
- (c) provide on-site occupational therapy services to patients in hospitals / medical institutions / non-governmental organizations (NGOs) / client's home, etc.;
- (d) provide clinical education to local, the Chinese mainland and overseas occupation therapy students at the Rehabilitation Service Centre;
- (e) assist in promotion of occupational therapy services to the general public, institutions, mass media and referral agents;
- (f) conduct health-related talks and seminars;
- (g) provide occupational therapy training locally and outside Hong Kong when necessary;
- (h) supervise Occupational Therapists and Occupational Therapy Assistants;
- (i) assist in selected research activities at the Rehabilitation Service Centre; and
- (j) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of Department and his delegates.

The appointee may be required to work on shift, and on Saturdays and Sundays.

**Qualifications**

Applicants should:

- (a) have a bachelor's degree in Occupational Therapy or equivalent and a master's degree in Occupational Therapy / Rehabilitation Sciences / Health Studies or related disciplines;
- (b) be registered as Part I with the Hong Kong Occupational Therapists Board and have a valid practising certificate;
- (c) have at least five years of relevant post-qualification working experience in the field of physical rehabilitation with medical-neurological and musculoskeletal rehabilitation inclusive;
- (d) have good interpersonal and communication skills; and
- (e) be independent and able to work with other disciplines.

Applicants with less experience may be considered for the post of Occupational Therapist II.

Preference will be given to those with working experience in an out-patient or private clinic and with a higher educational/professional qualification.

**Remuneration and Conditions of Service**

A highly competitive remuneration package will be offered. Initial appointment will be on a fixed-term gratuity-bearing contract. Re-engagement thereafter is subject to mutual agreement. Applicants should state their current and expected salary in the application.
