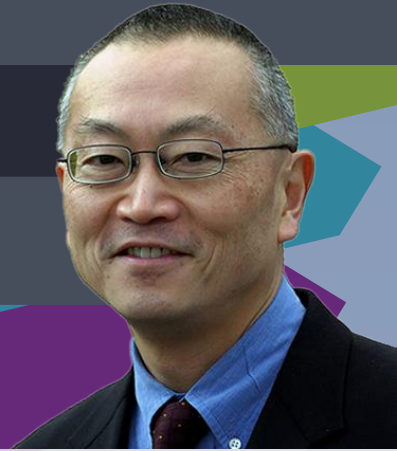

He also made notable contributions in assisting the Hong Kong SAR Government during the outbreak of H5N1 avian influenza in 1997 and the outbreak of SARS in 2003 in the city.
