Guidelines for Submissions

Manuscripts submitted to the 12th APF should be original contributions and should not have been previously published nor under consideration for publication elsewhere. Individual and multiple authors are welcome to contribute

We accept <u>only full papers</u> for consideration hence all competitive papers must be submitted following the guidelines for a full paper.

However papers that are accepted have the option to be published as a full paper or an extended abstract.

- Font: Times New Roman 12pt
- Margins: 1 inch all sides
- Spacing: Double Spaced.
- Abstract: Maximum of 150 words
- Title: No more than 2 lines of text
- Total length: 7 pages (including title, abstract, main body, tables and references)
- Referencing style: APA 6th Edition format
- The title page is the first page and should contain the title of the paper, name of author(s) or authors' names, institutional affiliation, present position and complete address (including telephone/fax and e-mail).
- Order of Paper for Submission
 - 1. Title
 - 2. Abstract
 - 3. Introduction/Background
 - 4. Main body of the paper including tables
 - 5. Reference list
- Author's name should not appear anywhere except on the cover page of only <u>main</u> copy of the manuscript (to preserve anonymity during the blind review process).
- Soft copy of the manuscript in the form of MS WORD file attachment must be sent to the following email: paolo.mura@taylors.edu.my
- Upon acceptance, those wishing to only publish an extended abstracts follow the same guidelines but are restricted to a maximum of one page including references.
