Invitation for Presentation Proposals:

Presentation proposals are now invited on any topics relating to tourism research, education and training bridging theory and practice. The aim of the Symposium is to foster dialogue and share "good practices" in tourism research, education and training which contribute and enhance tourism practices both in public and private sectors, particularly for responsible, sustainable and accessible tourism development in Asia and the Pacific region.
