Study Abroad Fund



At least <u>5 full-day</u> of offshore experience (exclude Chinese Mainland) which is credit bearing or formally assessed by programme provider, or endorsed by academic units

Recommended Type of Activities

- Fee-paying <u>Short-term programmes</u> offered by PolyU Partner Institutions, or endorsed by academic units
- Programme-related study tours or field trips arranged by academic units.
- International competition or conference (student participating as audience) that are reputable
 and influential in the field and of beneficial to students in terms of personal, academic and
 professional development. Endorsement from academic units is recommended.
- Other offshore learning experience that are credit bearing or formally assessed.

Funding Amount

Asia HK\$3,000 (5 – 27 days) and HK\$6,000 (28 days up)

Outside Asia HK\$5,000 (5 – 27 days) and HK\$10,000 (28 days up)



Study Abroad Fund does not support internship (WIE), service learning, International Student Exchange or Chinese Mainland & Taiwan Exchange, Summer@OxBridge or ICCPS subsidy recipients.
