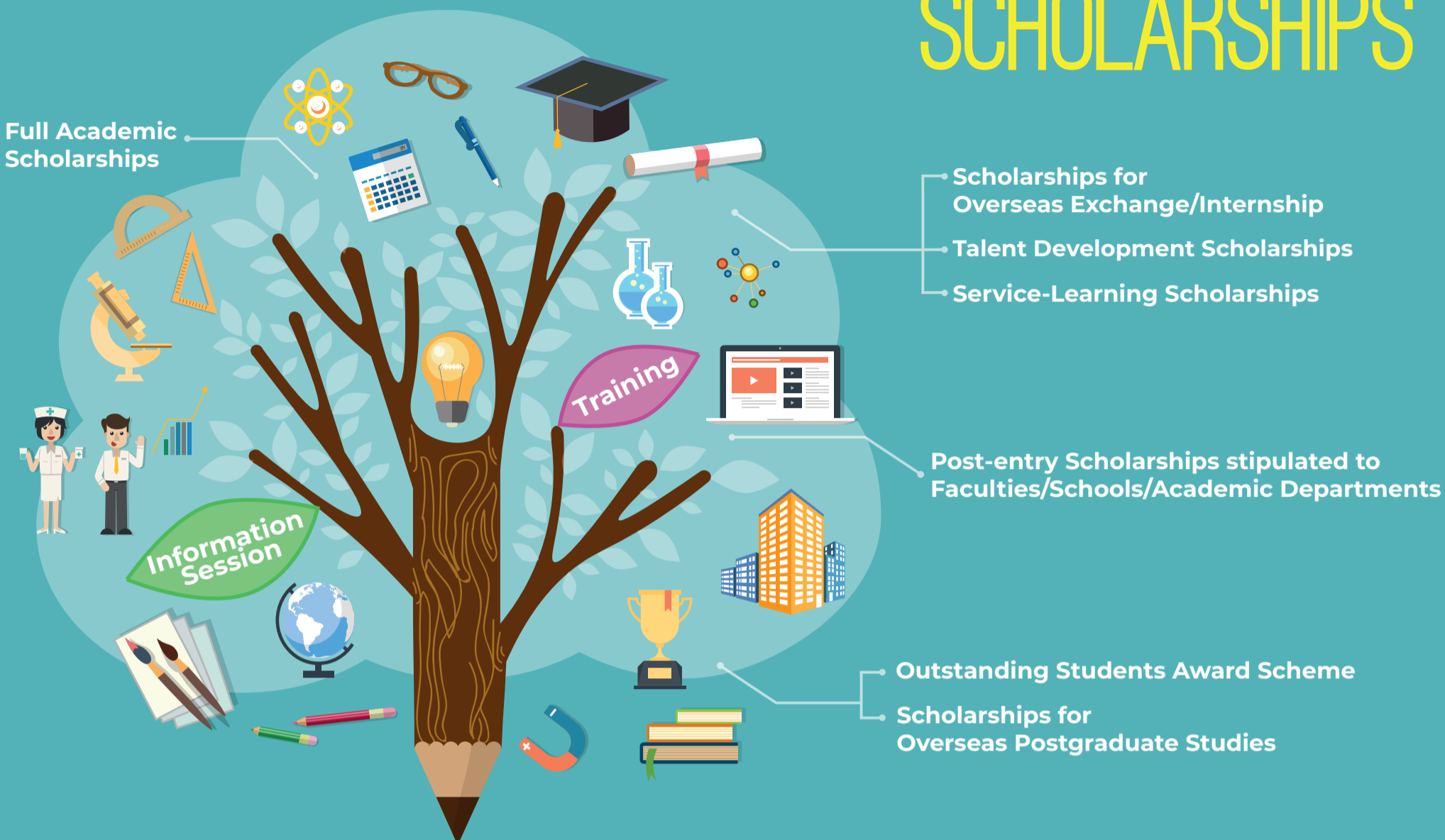


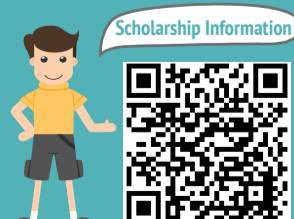

HSBC Overseas Scholarship Scheme (Note 2)	By Nomination	Scholarship(s), with a maximum value of \$300,000 each, covering tuition fees, a minimum economy return airfare, and reasonable academic and living expenses of a one-semester or one-year overseas studies	October/November 2020	Local non-final-year degree students
Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme (Note 2)	By Nomination	Each scholarship covers a Overseas/Mainland Attachment Programme, Mentorship Programme, a Service Project Programme and an optional Local Internship Programme	October/November 2020	Local non-final-year degree students
HKSAR Government Scholarship Fund - Talent Development Scholarship	By Application	Valued at \$10,000 each to recognize students with demonstrated talent in non-academic areas	January/February 2021	Full-time students at HD level or above
HKSAR Government Scholarship Fund - Reaching Out Award	By Nomination	Valued at \$10,000 each to encourage students to participate in outreaching activities outside Hong Kong	January/February 2021	Full-time students at HD level or above

Other aspects such as involvement in extra-curricular activities & community services, leadership potential and financial need of the candidates may also be taken into consideration.
