Erasmus Mundus Scholars

Dr Venus Lun, SRC Director, and Dr Mike Lai, SRC Deputy Director, received funding from the Erasmus Mundus to visit City University London as scholars for the Coastal and Marine Engineering and Management Programme (CoMEM). Funded by the European Commission, CoMEM is run under a consortium involving five European universities, namely NTNU in Norway, TU Delft in the Netherlands, UPC in Spain, and the University of Southampton and City University London in the UK. Erasmus Mundus Scheme aims to support the establishment of cooperation partnerships between European higher education institutions and higher education institutions from targeted countries with the objective of organizing and implementing structured individual mobility arrangements between the European and partner institutions.
