The "Hong Kong Scholars Program" is jointly launched by the Society of Hong Kong Scholars and the China National Postdoctoral Council under the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security, China. The program aims at effectively pooling talent and research resources of Hong Kong and the Mainland to train outstanding postdoctoral fellows. Selected "Hong Kong Scholars" (i.e., the postdoctoral fellows) will come to Hong Kong to conduct postdoctoral research work under the supervision of professors at various universities in Hong Kong.


Dr Kee-hung Lai, Deputy Director of SRC, will be the supervisor of a postdoctoral fellow graduating from the School of Management and Economics of the Beijing Institute of Technology. They will be working on green logistics and shipping issues in China under the Hong Kong Scholars Program. The Hong Kong Scholars Program is a program under which the Mainland Government recommends top PhD graduates to work in Hong Kong and provides half of the salary of the postdoctoral fellow working in Hong Kong. This is the second time Dr Lai serves as the supervisor for this Program.
