

Dr. Kee-hung Lai (Mike Lai) is Chair Professor of Shipping and Logistics at the Department of Logistics and Maritime Studies, Faculty of Business, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is also the Director of the Shipping Research Centre at the University. While being the Editor-in-Chief of the *International Journal of Shipping and Transport Logistics* and the *Journal of Shipping and Trade*, he also serves on the boards of *IEEE Transactions on Engineering Management*, *Industrial Marketing Management*, *Information & Management*, *Maritime Business Review*, and *Transportation Research Part E*.

Dr. Lai has co-authored over 200 articles in scholarly journals, including *California Management Review*, *Journal of Operations Management*, and *Production and Operations Management*, with an h-index of 81 and total citations more than 30,000 based on Google Scholar Citations. In a study in the *International Journal of Production Economics* (Charting Leadership in Supply Chain Management Research from Asia and Europe by Babber et al., 2018, vol. 203, pp 350-378), he is listed as one of the top 25 SCM authors from Asia. He is also recognized as “Highly Cited Researcher 2019” in Web of Science, World’s top 2% most cited scientist, “Updated science-wide author databases of standardized citation indicators,” Stanford University, December 2022, best business and management scientist by Research.com, ranked #6 in China (#91 worldwide), 2022.
