

## LMS Research Postgraduate Student Symposium 2022

The symposium aims to serve as a communication channel for MPhil and PhD students registered in the Department of Logistics and Maritime Studies (LMS) to share their research interests and outcomes with their peers as well as with a panel of faculty members. It also aims to help build a supportive and collaborative research environment within the department as we envision student participants gain as much by interacting with their peers as by having their presentations commented or discussed by the faculty panel.

The symposium will be a one-day event, where LMS research postgraduate students will be invited to give a **30-minute** presentation in front of their peers as well as a team of faculty members. The faculty members will offer a critique of each presentation and provide advice.

### Submission

All MPhil and PhD students are invited to submit a **one-page abstract** from the areas of logistics, operations management, maritime, aviation and transport studies. The abstract should clearly state the problem being addressed and the description of the progress to date.

All submissions must be written in English. The abstract submission should be accompanied with a cover letter stating your name, supervisor's name and email address, programme start date, and 3-5 keywords describing your work. **Please combine all materials into one word document and submit to Anne Wong at [anne-ly.wong@polyu.edu.hk](mailto:anne-ly.wong@polyu.edu.hk).**

*A certificate of "Outstanding Presentation Award" will be given to the student(s) who has/have the best presentation as assessed by the faculty panel.*
