Topic: Doctoral Consortium

Abstract

The Doctoral Consortium aims to assist doctoral students to build their research and professional network with peers, and integrate into the international academic knowledge exchange. A small group of doctoral students are asked to give a short presentation (10 minutes) about their research study to peers and faculty, who would ask questions and provide feedback and guidance on the research. Preference will be given to students employing empirical research approaches.

Her research interests are environmental management, supply chain integration, and reverse logistics.
