

He is in charge of the Platforms of the City Information Modeling of Suzhou and the BIM based Management Platform of the Digital Planning and Construction for Xiong'an. He published more than 100 papers and 3 books.

Abstract:

The practices of City Information Modeling, conducted by the Future City Lab of China Academy of Urban Planning & Design (CAUPD), aims to promote spatial sharing that all the stakeholders and citizens have the opportunities of accessing the full life cycle of planning, construction and management of a city regarding spatial arrangements.
