- Level 2 or above in Mathematics, Liberal Studies; AND
- Attained Level in Citizenship and Social Development; AND
- Level 3 in 2 Other Elective subjects [may include Extended Modules of Mathematics (M1/M2)]

For Non-local Applicants

Qualifications meeting the general minimum entrance requirements of the University will also be considered.

Study Path

Year 1

- · All students study a common curriculum in Year One.
- Students rank their choices of the below Major programmes in order of preference by the end of Semester 2 of Year One

BSc (Hons) in Language Sciences and Analytics (BScLSA)

• JUPAS applicants with a HKDSE score of 30.0* or above in any best 5 subjects will be guaranteed admission into aprogramme of their choice (from Year 2 to Year 4). Other than 'guaranteed' admission cases, priority of programme choice from Year 2 to Year 4 will be based on students' GPA of all discipline-specific requirement subjects at the end of their first year studies

Year 2 - 4

· Students complete their own Major programme over the following 3 years.
