Navigating towards Successful Research Grant Proposals

Abstract

This workshop will focus on the fundamentals and the art of writing successful research grant proposals. We will also review strategies for avoiding common problems seen in unsuccessful proposals. Whether you are an established or new scholar, please come to learn ways to enhance your success in research grant competitions.

The workshop discussion leader is Prof. Carolyn Egri. Prof. Egri has been the recipient of a number of research grants during her academic career. She also has extensive experience assessing applications for research grant agencies including the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada, Research Grants Council of Hong Kong, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Investment Climate and Business Environment Research Fund, and Israeli Science Fund. She has served on 18 research grant adjudication committees, and was chair for 14 of those committees.

Carolyn Egri is the William J.A. Rowe EMBA Alumni Professor, and professor of management and organization studies at the Beedie School of Business, Simon Fraser University. Prof. Egri has published extensively on international management, cross-cultural values and ethics, and corporate environmental and social responsibility. Her research has been published in top tier journals including the *Academy of Management Journal*, *Journal of International Business Studies*, *Organization Science*, and *Strategic Management Journal*.

Prof. Egri is the Associate Editor, Essays, Dialogues, and Interviews for *Academy of Management Learning & Education*, has co-edited four journal special issues, and currently serves on seven editorial boards. She has been chair of the Academy of Management's Organizations and the Natural Environment interest group, a director of the Organizational Behavior Teaching Society, and chair of the adjudication committees for the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada. Prof. Egri is the 2012 recipient of the David L. Bradford Outstanding Educator Award from the Organizational Behavior Teaching Society for Management Educators.
