What will students do to serve?	Providing services to the elderly and uneducated homeowners affected by urban renewal process. The major role of the students is to play as a service advisor to the disadvantaged group in addressing the problems they are facing or likely to face and how to take appropriate actions to tackle them. Students are expected to develop planned activities and execute same for the community services component, under the guidance of the social workers of the collaborated NGO. Activities may include home visits, identifying the specific needs of the homeowners, explaining and advising the appropriate procedures under the relevant ordinances and advising on the estimated price level of the homes of the elderly homeowners etc.
