They will be required to use their knowledge and skills acquired in class to help the farmers and the community on agricultural production, including but not limit to vegetable, mushroom and herb. It is targeted to enhance the efficiency in using various resources, especially on energy, raise in productivity level, reduce in default rate, and to enhance the crop quality and quantity. Students will use computer simulated models, fabrication of agricultural devices and by any other modes or demonstrations, including active involvement in routine farming activities, so as to help and to communicate with the rural farmers and community in need.
