Service Project	
What will students do to serve?	Students will be divided into inter-professional teams of about 4 or 5 members and taught using a collaborative learning approach. Each interactive tutorial group will consist of 25-30 students, during which they plan the service learning projects. They have to communicate directly with the community organization, and plan and conduct the projects under the guidance of mentors, who may be an academic staff from one of the FHSS depts. Examples of projects include conducting health education talks for elderly with cognitive impairment, assessment of balance and mobility for elderly, organizing health assessment for people with physical and mental disabilities (e.g. measuring blood pressure, weight and height etc.), designing exercise programmes and organizing recreational activities for people with disabilities.
