Examples of activities areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Assisting speech therapists in conducting evaluation session and data analysis •Leading various group activities, educational programme and conducting post –treatment probe test under supervision of speech therapists and social workers •Conducting revision sessions with children and caregivers to consolidate what they have learnt during the programme •Having phone contacts with caregivers regularly to monitor children’s progress and their home practice, report their post-treatment evaluation results and give recommendation with the guidance of speech therapists and social workers
