What will students do to serve?	<p>Students will be asked to deliver I.T. lessons/workshops to local students in secondary school or children in an orphanage. During the service trip, the students are expected to spend 10 to 14 days and be divided into teams to conduct the workshops. The I.T. workshops will include mini-lectures, tutorial exercises, and hands-on practice. Students will be responsible for teaching different parts of the workshops. They will take turns to teach, and all students will contribute to teaching some parts. While one student is taking the role of teacher, the other students will take the role of teaching assistants to assist the hands-on practice during I.T. workshops. The service recipients will learn and practice different I.T. skills throughout the service period.</p> <p>In case of Covid-19 and not possible to go overseas, we will either conduct I.T. workshops in primary/secondary schools in Hong Kong or online I.T. workshops for the service recipients overseas.</p>
Whom will students serve?	The service recipients are the junior secondary school students of the communities that lack proficient I.T. knowledge in Cambodia.
