邓杨金喜纪念奖学金

奖学金之成立

邓杨金喜女士是一位非常出色的职业治疗师、临床实习导师和部门主管。担任香港医院管理局行政经理期间，杨女士积极参与职业治疗专业的发展并致力提高小区职业治疗服务。杨女士虽然不敌癌症不幸于二零零三年逝世，但她却无私地将个人储蓄捐献给香港理工大学康复治疗科学系以培育职业治疗学生及发展职业治疗专业。杨女士早年获得政府保送英国进修职业治疗专业训练，因此她也希望以同样的方式资助学生修读职业治疗课程。为了纪念邓杨金喜女士及发扬其致力发展职业治疗专业的精神，我们设立了「邓杨金喜纪念奖学金」，资助杰出学生修读职业治疗课程。

奖学金内容

- 奖学金资助学生修读由香港理工大学所开办的全日制「职业治疗学硕士学位课程」的部份学费。
- 奖学金名额及最高金额(港币):
职业治疗学硕士学位课程，每届两名，各可获高达港币二十万。
- 奖学金得主必需在完成课程后，于中国内地从事康复领域相关的工作，为期三年。
- 奖学金得主若未能履行奖学金义务，需全额缴还已领之奖学金，并须缴付罚款(奖学金百分之二十之款项)。



职业治疗

是一种针对短暂或永久性身体、心理、行为、智力、社交方面之残障人士的康复治疗专业。通过具治疗性质之活动，职业治疗使残障人士提高全人发展能力，帮助接受治疗人士掌握所需生活技能，协助他们重返家庭、重回工作岗位、重新投入社群生活，以实现独立、有意义和丰富的人生。

申请资格

- 居住在中国境内之中国公民因经济能力有限而不能修读职业治疗相关的深造课程。
- 学业成绩优异，康复临床表现出色。
- 中文与英文说写流利。
- 符合香港理工大学入读深造课程的英语水平。
- 具备致力发展中国内地职业治疗专业的热诚并曾在其工作单位致力开展职业治疗服务。
- 致力领导发展职业治疗专业。
- 具备致力推展中国内地职业治疗教育及服务的热诚。

申请程序

- 每年在中港两地刊登申请奖学金的消息。

- 奖学金申请者需于指定日期前寄回本系下列申请文件：申请表、成绩单和学历证件副本各乙份及其它证明文件。
- 奖学金申请者须同时向香港理工大学入学组提交上述深造课程申请。
- 申请人必须提供托福/雅思国际英语测试成绩单，如未能提供所述之学历，申请将不会被考虑。
- 透过初部遴选，已获取录取入读全日制「职业治疗学硕士学位课程」的合资格申请者会被安排面试。

Cynthia Tang Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Establishment

Mrs Cynthia Tang was a dedicated occupational therapy (OT) practitioner and clinical educator, as well as a diligent leader and manager of the allied health and rehabilitation professions in the Hospital Authority. She passed away on the Christmas day of 2003 following her courageous battle with cancer. Mrs Tang has made major contribution over the years in educating OT students.

As Mrs Tang was sponsored to study OT in the UK through a government scholarship scheme, she wished to support other potential students to study the OT programme. In memory of Mrs Tang and her chosen career in OT profession, a student scholarship to support outstanding students in the Mainland China to study OT programme of PolyU is set up and named as "Cynthia Tang Memorial Scholarship".

Scholarship Value

- The Scholarship will cover part of the tuition fee of Master in Occupational Therapy Programme in full-time basis.
- Scholarship quota and amount:
Master in Occupational Therapy Programme: two quotas per year, maximum amount of HK\$200,000 for each quota.
- The awardee has to work in Mainland China for three years soon after the graduation in rehabilitation field.
- The awardees are required to repay the scholarship amount received plus 20% of the scholarship as the penalty if he/she failed to fulfil the 3 years of OT services in Mainland China after graduation.



Occupational Therapy aims to help people with disabilities to achieve their optimum level of functioning. By taking part in therapeutic activities, both the physical and the psychosocial functions of clients are enhanced or maintained. Occupational therapists also help their clients to restore their roles in the family, the workplace and the community.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

- Successful applicant of Master in Occupational Therapy (MOT) programme. Regarding the application for MOT admission, applicants should refer to the website at <https://www.polyu.edu.hk/rs/study/postgraduate-entry-level-studies/master-in-occupational-therapy/>
- Chinese citizen who lives in Mainland China with limited financial support to study the postgraduate programme of PolyU.
- Has outstanding/excellent track record in academic and/or clinical work in rehabilitation field.
- Possesses good written and fluent spoken Chinese and English.
- Meets the English language proficiency requirement for admission into postgraduate programme in PolyU.
- Able to demonstrate commitment to develop OT profession in Mainland China with a good track record to establish the OT service within his/her organisation.
- Has passion in OT profession and intention of leadership in the field.
- Has demonstrated enthusiasm in promoting OT education and services in Mainland China.

Application Procedures

- Application will be called annually.

- Applicants are requested to send all necessary documents (Application form, photocopies of certificates, transcripts, TOEFL Score Report or IELTS Test Report and other relevant documents) to Department of Rehabilitation Sciences, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University before the Scholarship application deadline.
- Applicants should complete the applications for the above-mentioned programmes before submitting the Scholarship application.
- A Scholarship selection interview will be organised for all applicants who have been granted with offers to study in Master in Occupational Therapy Programme in full-time basis.
