- (1) <u>Medical expenses</u>: **HK\$23,800** is the maximum deduction of medical expenses in AFI formula per family member with chronic illness/permanent disability.
- (2) You can use the calculator at "SFO E-link" (<u>ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk</u>) to roughly estimate the amount of grant and loan you might obtain from the TSFS. Please note that the government's Student Finance Office (SFO) will accept information supported by the documentary proof provided. If documentary proofs provided are NOT substantiated (e.g. self-written income statement, unexplained prolonged unemployment), SFO may need to make adjustments and apply benchmark figures on the basis of statistical information provided by the relevant government departments, such as the Census and Statistics Department and the Rating and Valuation Department, etc. to assess the income and/or net value of assets concerned. SFO may also apply projected figures in the family income in the assessment if necessary.
- (3) Maximum grant levels may be adjusted upwards for students required to take part in **overseas** <u>compulsory</u> field trips in 2025/26. Applications for such will be submitted to the SFO via respective Department/School and Student Affairs Office (SAO). Final approval is subject to the confirmation of the SFO.
