



# HKSAR Government Scholarship 2025/26 The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Scholarship 2025/26

The HKSAR Government and PolyU have set up two separate scholarship funds to recognise the achievements of outstanding PolyU students pursuing full-time undergraduate degree programmes. The details are listed below:

#### No. & Value of Scholarships:

For HKSAR Government Scholarship, around HK\$2.6M is available. The value of each award for the local and non-local students is HK\$40,000 and HK\$80,000 respectively.

For The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Scholarship, around 20 one-off scholarships valued at HK\$40,000 each are available.

## **Eligibility and Selection Criteria:**

- All <u>current</u> bachelor degree students in the 2025/26 academic year who were <u>admitted into a PolyU full-time</u> government-funded undergraduate degree programme in or before 2024/25 academic year.
- The awardees should have
  - academic excellence (with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.70 by the end of 2024/25);
  - attained a minimum of 24 credits in 2024/25 (including the transferred credits of the subjects taken in 2024/25); and
  - achievement/involvement in extra-curricular activities and/or community services, demonstrated leadership and good communication skills in the <u>past two academic years</u>.
- By the deadline of application, the applicants should <u>not</u> be holding entry scholarship(s) or other post-entry scholarship(s) [excluding scholarship for exchange/overseas studies] in 2025/26 with an individual value equal to or above the tuition fee level of the applicants in 2025/26.
- The disciplinary record(s) of the applicants with PolyU will be taken into consideration.
- In cases where candidates have equal merit on other selection criteria, preference should be given to students with financial needs (*only applicable to The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Scholarship*).
- The awardees should maintain a <u>full-time student status in Semester One and Two</u> in 2025/26 in PolyU. (Students on deferment of studies in Semester One or Two of 2024/25 or 2025/26 or students to be graduated upon completion of Semester One of 2025/26 are <u>not</u> eligible.)
- The awardees are required to maintain a satisfactory level of academic performance in 2025/26. Otherwise, PolyU reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship already awarded to the awardees.

## Selection:

The awardees will be selected by a selection panel comprising PolyU academic staff members. The decision of the panel is final.

### Remarks:

- Applicants need to concurrently apply for the HKSAR Government Scholarship and The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Scholarship. The successful applicants would only be granted <u>either one</u> of the Scholarships.
- The "HKSAR Government Scholarship 2025/26" may be renewed to the same recipient subject to his/her attainment of a <u>yearly GPA</u> of at least 3.5 in the previous academic year and fulfillment of other award conditions, and availability of funding. Please note "The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Scholarship" is non-renewable.
- The awardees of HKSAR Government Scholarship in 2024/25 <u>need **not** respond</u> to this application invitation.

#### **Enquiry & Application:**

- Completed application form with supporting documents should be submitted to Student Affairs Office (SAO) via SAO's <u>Scholarship Application System</u> on or before 23.59 on 29 September 2025 (Monday). - The applicants will be notified of the selection results in or before mid-December 2025.
