

The Albert Young Foundation Limited's Scholarship 2023/24

The Albert Young Foundation Limited has made available HK\$100,000 to The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) in the 2023/24 academic year. The Scholarships are now open for application and the details are as follows:

Number & Value of Award:

5 – 10 scholarships totaling HK\$100,000, with individual value ranging from HK\$10,000 – \$20,000.

Eligibility:

- Current full-time local undergraduate PolyU students pursuing government-funded undergraduate degree programmes of any discipline.

Selection Criteria:

- Excellent academic results (minimum cumulative GPA in Semester 1 of 2023/24 should be over 3.0)
- Financial needs will also be taken into consideration. Those applicants who have successfully applied the Government's Tertiary Student Finance Scheme-Publicly funded Programmes (TSFS) will be given priority.
- The applicants are required to contribute a minimum of 10 hours of voluntary community services in the current academic year. Please note that only those proven voluntary services will be considered.
- The disciplinary record(s) of the candidates with PolyU (if any) may be taken into consideration in the processing of applications.

A selection panel comprising PolyU staff members will shortlist the suitable candidates. The nominations will then be forwarded to the Donor for final approval.

Remarks:

Upon approval of the nominations, the awardees shall submit a report to the Donor by the end of 2023/24 academic year.
