Faculty of Construction and Environment

The Faculty of Construction and Environment (FCE) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) is the biggest provider of higher education for the Hong Kong construction industry. Its four Departments offer a wide range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes, and almost all of the undergraduate programmes have received formal recognition from professional bodies of the construction industry. In the 2017 QS Subject Rankings, PolyU was ranked 10th for the subject of Civil and Structural Engineering.

With eight research centres, FCE has the largest concentration of research expertise in Hong Kong in construction-related disciplines. Graduates find good employment in a wide range of industrial, commercial, as well as public and government organisations as, to name a few, professional engineers and builders, quantity surveyors, land surveyors, and project managers.

Department of Building Environment and Energy Engineering

The Department of Building Environment and Energy Engineering (BEEE), officially established in 1981 (formerly the Department of Building Services Engineering), aims at nurturing multidisciplinary professionals who apply art and science in design, installation, commissioning, as well as operation and maintenance of services systems for buildings. Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering

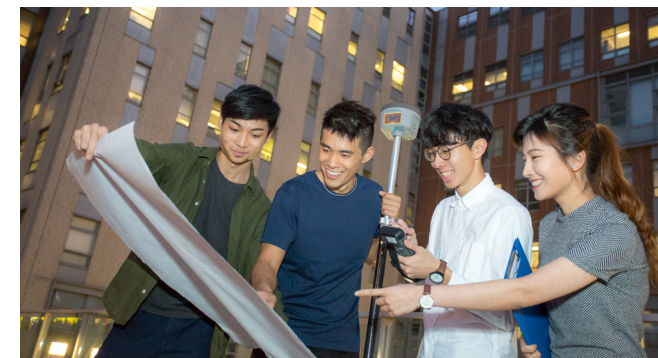
