The Faculty of Humanities (FH) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) is young, but it is fast gaining international recognition through its strong academic links. It has established joint research centres with Peking University, Tsinghua University, and Xi'an Jiaotong University, and exchange programmes with leading universities worldwide. In 2011 and 2012, FH was granted by the European Commission the first and only Erasmus Mundus mobility programme in Hong Kong for academic exchange with European higher education institutions and those from South East Asia. With an aim of becoming an international hub for language and cultural studies, FH strives to provide high quality programmes at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, and offer research degrees and post-doctoral fellowships in a wide range of linguistics, applied language studies, and Chinese culture-related areas.

Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies

The mission of the Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies (CBS) is to offer high quality programmes which equip preferred graduates with high levels of biliterate and trilingual skills and abilities which are to be used effectively in a wide range of professions.

General Education Centre

Established in 1998, the General Education Centre (GEC) offers a wide range of General Education subjects to full-time undergraduates at PolyU. All of the subjects GEC offers put emphasis on the importance of interdisciplinary studies and the cultivation of critical and creative thinking. GEC is currently offering three credit-bearing Cluster Area Requirement subjects in collaboration with the Chinese and English Language Centres. It also offers a Service-Learning Subject for undergraduate students.
