International Rankings of SD



- Since 2015, SD has been ranked one of the top in the globe on the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings by Subject - Art and Design. Currently it is one of the top in Asia and the 16th in the world.
- SD was listed as one of the Top 10 Best Industrial Design Schools in the World in 2015 and one of the Special Mention Graphic Design Schools in the World by Design Schools Hubs in 2016.

James Dyson Award 2018 and China Universities Industrial Design Competition 2018

The School's Product Design student LO Kin Pan's creation "POD" brought him the honours of International Top 20 & National Winner (Hong Kong) at the James Dyson Award 2018, and the Silver Prize in China Universities Industrial Design Competition 2018. "POD" is a multi-functional furniture designed for low-income people who face the problems of superstorm and flooding frequently.

53rd Central Glass Architectural Design Competition

Year 4 student CHEN Shuning (Environment and Interior Design) on winning a Merit in the 53rd Central Glass Architectural Design Competition in Japan. Her project "Pre-Cyberocracy 2050 – semi-automatic city" brought her the award with a cash prize of 50,000 yen and the opportunity to meet with some internationally renowned architectural masters at the award presentation ceremony held on 10 November 2018.

PENSOLE World Sneaker Championship 2018

BAO Qiancheng, the School's Year 4 Product Design student, won the PENSOLE World Sneaker Championship 2018. His design was inspired by the perspective lines of the crowded skyscrapers and neon signs in the metropolis Hong Kong. These inspirations became the radical direction shoe lacing system and the translucent soft TPU bar fused on the shoes. The design outcome has a clean and iconic silhouette and innovative structure.
