Established in 1979, the School of Hotel and Tourism Management (SHTM) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) has an active School Industry Advisory Committee that consists of industry leaders, who provide advice on curriculum and development matters, to ensure that the School's curricula mirror the realities and fulfil the needs of industry.

To scale new heights in the years ahead, an impressive 28-storey building was opened in Tsim Sha Tsui East in 2011 which features lecture halls, function rooms, the Vinoteca Lab (wine lab), Bistro 1979 (new training restaurant), the Samsung Digital Lab for Hospitality Technology, and the Che-woo Lui Hotel and Tourism Resource Centre.

Hotel ICON, opened in 2011, is the world's first purpose-built teaching and research hotel that fully integrates teaching, learning, and research in a full service environment.

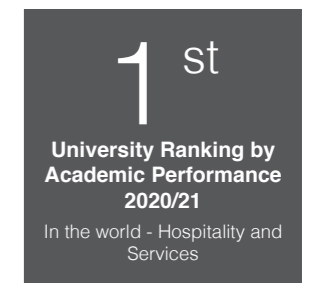
Features
