#### **Job Functions**

The Professor of Practice is expected to provide leadership in the development of the important discipline of Fashion and Textile Design and in the creative direction of the ITC.

The appointee will be required to:

- (a) play a leading role in the development of the discipline of fashion and creativity of the Institute;
- (b) provide creative leadership and inspiration in the management of the relevant programme area:
- (c) teach and contribute to curriculum development at undergraduate and/or postgraduate levels as appropriate;
- (d) provide leadership in developing collaborations and partnerships with the fashion industry and fashion institutions around the world;
- (e) initiate, lead and participate in high-level practice-based consultancy and other scholarly activities leading to exhibitions and international recognitions to the Institute;
- (f) undertake academic and departmental administrative duties; and
- (g) perform any other duties as assigned by the Head of Institute or his delegates.

# **Qualifications**

Applicants should:

- (a) demonstrate a high degree of achievement and professional practice in fashion and textile design. A doctotal degree in Fashion/Textile Design or related disciplines would be preferred but not essential;
- (b) have sound knowledge of university teaching and learning and/or research/industrial experience in fashion design, textile design, knitwear design, product development or related areas at postgraduate level;
- (c) have substantial industrial experience or practice-based outcomes of a high level, a solid record of exhibitions, shows, production designs of high level or research and publication in high-quality scholarly journals;
- (d) have a track record of academic management and a good understanding of quality assurance procedures;
- (e) have experience in working with students from a wide range of cultural backgrounds and a good record of student success (international competitions and awards, graduate destinations, etc.);
- (f) be aware of current pedagogic practice with strong industry links and have excellent communication and networking skills; and
- (g) be passionate about fashion education and willing to work flexibly.
