Objectives of Summer Internship Programme

Local and off-shore internships are available for undergraduates:

- 1. To nurture, groom and equip our future leaders in the fashion and textile industry through collaboration between university and industry partners
- 2. To encourage students to contribute to the workplace and prepare for their university-to-work transition
- 3. To provide students with the experience of working in a dynamic business environment while developing a range of generic skills and professional competence

Basic Requirements

- Outstanding academic performance (min. GPA 3.2)
- Language proficiency
- Strong communication and presentation skills
- Positive attitude
- Strong passion for fashion

Selected students are required to attend predeparture briefing, training and workshops before the commencement of summer internship programme.



Eligibility



Duration: student interns are required to work in full-time basis (5 days per week and 8 hours per day) for 7 weeks minimum during the summer break (3 Jun - 30 Aug 2024)



Interviews will be conducted in March 2024

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CREDITS	

They are required to take this programme as a credit-bearing elective subject (*Professional Attachment*)



They are closely monitored by subject lecturers



Programme Features



Mini-Project

Companies are expected to provide a mini-project to student interns, which enables them to connect classroom theory with workplace applications.

Suggested scope and contents are:

- Market, industry, company research
- Data collection and analysis
- Solutions to address the real-life fashion business environment issues
- Integration of theoretical and practical issues to diagnose
 work-related problems
- Any projects which can generate practical insights of the fashion and textile industry



Progress Monitoring

Student interns are closely monitored by subject lecturers through email, teleconversation, personal consultation, progress report and final report.

The subject lecturers might also contact the employer (attachment supervisor) to understand and monitor the students' performance.

Progress Monitoring

All interns are required to submit term report and learning portfolio for assessment.

Interns who perform below standard level will be given poor grades or even 'FAIL'.

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Regarding coverage of accidents during work, PolyU provides Group Personal Accident Insurance coverage for basic protection to students participating in local, mainland China or overseas internship.

Student interns should report <u>immediately</u> to SFT and their employer if there is an accident.

EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

To offer students better protection when working in Hong Kong, company partners may consider taking out the Employment Compensation (EC) for the interns which offers a greater compensation in case of claims

GROUP TRAVEL INSURANCE PLAN

PolyU has a Group Travel insurance plan for additional coverage for students in offshore placements
