Key Responsibilities:

- **Design & Trend Research:** Assist the design team in mood board creation, trend research, and sketching for upcoming knitwear collections.
- **3D Digital Knit Design & Rendering:** Gain hands-on exposure to advanced digital fashion software, utilizing **CLO3D** and the **Shima Seiki APEX system** for 3D virtual prototyping, garment rendering, and simulation.
- **AI Tool Integration:** Explore and assist in applying **AI tools/knowledge** within the design process for pattern generation, inspiration, or visual concepts.
- **Stitch & Yarn Development:** Help develop and organize knit swatches, stitch libraries, and explore different yarn combinations/gauges.
- **Tech Pack Preparation:** Support designers in creating detailed Technical Packs (Tech Packs), including flat sketches and stitch specifications for production.

Requirements:

- Current students pursuing a Diploma/Degree in Knitwear Design, Fashion Design, Textiles, or related creative disciplines
- Passionate about knitwear structures, textures, yarns, and digital fashion.
- Proficiency or strong interest in **CLO3D** and Adobe Creative Suite (Illustrator, Photoshop). Knowledge of Shima Seiki APEX is a strong plus.
- Familiarity or a keen interest in utilizing **AI tools** for design enhancement.
- Detail-oriented, proactive, and excited to learn about the industrial manufacturing process.

- Practical experience inside a modern knitting factory, understanding how a design goes from sketch to physical garment.
- Real-world application of **3D fashion tools (CLO3D / Shima Seiki APEX)** and **AI workflows** in the garment industry.
