

#### **2+2 PROGRAMME** | OFFERED BY THE SHTM & MODUL UNIVERSITY VIENNA

For this option, students spend Year 1 + Year 2 at the SHTM, and Year 3 + Year 4 at Modul University Vienna. This option provides students with 2 awards: BSc (Hons) in Hotel and Tourism Management from the SHTM + BBA in Tourism and Hospitality Management from Modul University Vienna

#### PRE-GUARANTEED SPECIALISM ENTRY

For JUPAS applicants with HKDSE scores which are at least 10% or higher than the average score of the last admission exercise, they can be given pre-guaranteed entry into an individual specialism which they are interested in from the existing 3 specialisms, namely (1) Hotel Management, (2) Smart Tourism and Hospitality and (3) Event and Experience Management.



# WORK-INTEGRATED EDUCATION

Elite Management Programme

To fulfil the Work-Integrated Education requirement, you are required to complete 6 months or 960 hours of cumulative work experience during your studies. You will be placed at leading hotels, restaurant chains and tourism and events organisations in Hong Kong and abroad for work placements, which develop all-round students with professional competence and a refined sense of industry needs. You will be assigned a mentor from the School and a supervisor selected from our industry partners to help you integrate the two complementary aspects of your education.

Through Hotel ICON, the SHTM offers a unique internship programme which allows you to benefit from the hotel's transparent operations and gain a holistic understanding of the industry by participating in the day-to-day running of various departments in a real-world hotel environment. For the most outstanding SHTM students, the exceptional "Elite Management Programme" provides an opportunity to gain solid industry experience by rotating in different departments, undertaking special projects, and "shadowing" a Hotel ICON manager during internships.

## **OUR SCHOLARSHIPS**

The SHTM offers local and international students various scholarships based on exceptional academic merit, extracurricular activities, and community involvement. The School has been supported by donors in the hospitality and tourism industry, who have donated scholarships to encourage academic and personal excellence. These scholarships have helped our students achieve academic success and become well-rounded graduates.

Scholarships are usually awarded based on academic merit, but some are open to all students. Other factors, like leadership potential, financial need, and community involvement, are also considered. Applicants will be invited to interviews, and judges will evaluate their eligibility based on various factors.

# **ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

#### **Local Applicants**

The following HKDSE qualifications are required for local applicants:

- Level 3 in HKDSE Chinese Language
- Level 3 in HKDSE English Language
- Level 2 in HKDSE Mathematics
- Attained in HKDSE Citizenship and Social Development
- Level 3 in 2 HKDSE Elective Subjects

Interviews will be arranged for suitable candidates. Local applicants with qualifications other than HKDSE may also be considered.

#### **International Applicants**

International students are welcome to apply. A student visa is required to study in Hong Kong. After graduation, international students may stay in Hong Kong for up to 24 months to find employment.
